Flushing Fire Hydrants

Fire hydrants will be flushed Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, October 4th, 5th, and 6th, between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. During this time, you may notice a reduction in your water pressure.

Hydrant flushing may stir up sand and/or rust, and cause a discoloration of the water. Residents should run their water to check for discoloration before using. If you have any questions, please call City Hall at 695-3846.

Monday, October 3, 2010 will be the last day this season for brush pick-up. After October 3rd, brush will not be collected unless there is an emergency.

Leaf Pick-up Program

Street side leaf pick-up will start on October 10th. Rake your leaves to the back of the curb at the edge of the pavement; please - ***not into the street.*** Weather permitting, and machine operable, each zone will be covered in a one-week time frame.

Yard Waste Pick-up

October 3rd will be the last day for yard waste pick-up. The yard waste has to be in City approved, 30 gallon kraft paper bags available at City Hall for \$2.50 each.
