BENEFITS OF TREES

- Trees can increase property values.
- Two medium-size, healthy trees can supply the oxygen required for a single person for a year.
- Trees clean the air by absorbing greenhouse gases.
- Trees capture airborne particles such as dirt, dust, and soot. A mature tree can absorb 120 to 240 lbs. of particulate pollution each year.
- Trees and sidewalk gardens reduce flooding and water pollution. A mature tree can store 50 to 100 gallons of water during large storms.
- The presence of trees reduces the speed of drivers and reduces the frequency and severity of crashes.
- Trees and sidewalk gardens increase foot traffic in shopping districts.
- Trees provide a natural habitat for birds and insects.
- Street trees absorb traffic noise and increase privacy.
- Street trees build neighborhood and civic pride.
